In the Wings The Diary of Anne Frank

The Diary of Anne Frank opens on Friday, October 11th at 7:30 p.m. at The Varsity Center in Carbondale. Our production is adapted by Wendy Kesselman and includes newly discovered writings from the diary and survivor accounts.

From Director, Jo Ann Hensley:

"Anne Frank was both a typical teenage girl and a remarkable young woman.

She wanted to be noticed, to be admired, to have fun.

Like many teenagers, she bristled at being compared to a sibling, chaffed at being told what to do and how to act, and felt that those around her didn't really understand her.

Yet she was indeed a remarkable teenager. A gifted writer, she poured out her thoughts, feelings, and observations into her diary. The clarity of her voice and poignant quality of her insights are astonishing for any writer, let alone one so young.

Despite the constant fear, isolation, stress, and severe depravation, she wrote. Though she died when not yet sixteen, her voice provided a witness to silenced millions. Through it she achieved her desire to go on living after her death."
